




It is fun to enter through the revolving door at the front of the museum!




After entering the revolving doors, you will see our front desk. There will be a nice person to greet you. This is the person that your adult will show your passes to or get your tickets from.




As you explore the museum there is lots to see. Remember, in museums many of these things are old and delicate. We should look and not touch.

You can also see our awesome humpback whale skeleton. Did you know that it was put together by Stadium High School students?!






We have a fun exhibit where you can learn all about SCUBA diving.
