



# Washington State History Museum





The Washington State History Museum is a large brick building.



I will arrive at the museum by walking, car, bus, or light rail.



If I came by car, we will park in the parking lot. My adult will pay at the parking meter.





Once my adult pays at the meter, we can take the elevator to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor lobby.



If I arrive by bus or the lightrail, I will walk into the lobby on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.



The lobby is a big space where I go to check in. We will show our badge and the museum staff will put bands on our wrists.

We will put our bags, coats, food, and drinks in special lockers in the lobby.





When I go into the exhibits, I will stay where my adult can see me.



The lobby is on the 3rd floor. The first exhibit space is on the 3rd floor. It is called the Great Hall of Washington History.

I will look at the objects and pictures. Some objects I will have seen before and others will be new to me.





Some objects I cannot touch. They are behind a rail or glass. There are many things I can touch that are not behind a rail or glass.



When we're done in the Great Hall of Washington History, we will take the stairs or the elevator to the 5th floor. There are more exhibits with more objects and pictures. These exhibits will be different for each visit.



If I need to use the bathroom or get a drink of water, I can go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> floor. I can take the stairs or the elevator to get there.



If we brought snacks to eat, we can eat in the Activity Room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. If we want to buy snacks, we will visit Anthem Café out the front doors from the lobby.
